RESIDENTIAL LEAF COLLECTION

The City of Celina residential leaf pickup will begin on **October 23, 2017** and run weekly through **December 15, 2017**.

- Leaves are collected Tuesday through Friday in accordance with the established schedule and as weather conditions allow.
- Leaves must be placed at the curb, not in the street or across sidewalks.
- Avoid parking vehicles in the street during the collection period in your area. Do not park cars in or adjacent to any pile(s) of leaves.
- Do not mix branches with leaves. Limbs and branches collection will not begin until spring 2018.



LEAF PICKUP SCHEDULE

TUESDAY	Leaves will be picked up from Main Street west and from Market Street north.
WEDNESDAY	Leaves will be picked up from Main Street west and from Market Street south.
THURSDAY	Leaves will be picked up from Main Street east and from Wayne Street south.
FRIDAY	Leaves will be picked up from Main Street east and from Wayne Street north.

CITY COUNCIL MEETING DATES

Celina City Council meets on the second and fourth Mondays of every month, unless a Monday holiday requires rescheduling the meeting. **All meetings are held at 7 p.m. in the Council Chambers located on the 2nd floor of the City Administration Building, 225 N. Main Street.**

The agenda for each meeting is posted at the Celina Utilities Office, City Hall and the Library. The public is encouraged to attend these meetings with their input.

Celina Utilities Shut-off Policy

Prompt payment of your utility bills to avoid getting your services shut off is important. Any customer with a past-due account balance is subject to disconnect. Customers can determine their account status by checking their monthly utility bill. If your bill indicates you are in disconnect status, prompt payment is necessary to avoid having your utilities turned off.

Payments can be made to the Celina Utilities office with cash, check, automatic deduction from your bank account, or credit card. A night deposit box is located outside of the front doors for payment after working hours.

Any customer who has had their utilities turned off due to nonpayment, must make payment with cash or money order to be reconnected.
